Treasurer's Report

Current balance in the operating account: \$72, 616; high yield savings account: \$50,350.

The annual CC reported was completed and accepted.

Sarah is interested in keeping \$50,000 in the operating account while moving more into
the high yield savings account while monitoring the operating account monthly to maintain
that operating account balance. There is no penalty for moving funds in/out of the high
yield savings account. Motion to approve this change was made by Nancy 2nd by Abrie-
unanimous approval.

Operations Report

Eleven new dogs arrived in December. Five Australian hounds arrived in late December;
two are in Foster to Adopt, three are in foster. February 21 new hounds from Heather
Weir are slated to arrive - request was made for two females and one male.

New applications received: eleven in December, four in January. There are seventeen
approved applications, eight active applications.

Discussion ensued regarding the adoption fees. In the past year we have negotiated vet fees and cut the cost of electronic document signing. To match local adoption fees, it was proposed that all SA Greys hounds have a fixed fee of \$650, regardless of origin to be effective immediately. Motion made by Anne L; 2nd Ann P - unanimous approval. Rebound hound adoption would be charged only the cost of vet visit and boarding, not to exceed \$650. Hounds over 8 years old - adoption fee \$350. Motion to approve by Sarah; 2nd by Alice.
